Facilities Update

New steel doors have been installed in the dining hall.

The mouldy drywall has been removed from the bathroom in the Dauphin Building.

The flooring in the kitchen must be replaced before the camp can be opened. The plumbing and electrical connections in the kitchen have been disconnected in preparation for moving everything into the dining hall to replace the kitchen flooring.

On Oct. 17 Willowlake Baptist is planning a work bee to clear out the kitchen and install a subfloor.

We would like to replace the kitchen ceiling tiles with drywall while we have everything out of the kitchen. Could you provide a group of people to do the dry walling? We would like to get this done late October/early November.

Other jobs: Some of the stairs and decks on various buildings need repairing. The kitchen walls and ceiling will need painting after the drywall is installed. A new canoe rack needs to be built at the waterfront. Spring cleaning will need to be done.
